Offering action-packed racing since 1947, Martinsville Speedway is NASCAR's most historic and shortest track on the NASCAR Cup Series Race Circuit. The track is known for its famous Martinsville Speedway hot dog and for the many records drivers set while racing down its pavement.

Two NASCAR sanctioned race weekends are held at Martinsville Speedway each year, along with an annual Late Model Stock Car Race in the Fall. Other popular events include the Henry County Fair in September and Martinsville Speedway Toy Drive, held each December, where YOU can drive your own personal car around the track!

Celebrating over 75 years of racing, the Martinsville Speedway is a legend in motorsports. Martinsville Speedway is the only NASCAR track to host NASCAR Cup Series races since its inception in 1949. At slightly more than half a mile, Martinsville Speedway is the shortest track on the NASCAR Cup Series Race Circuit, but it's one of the biggest when it comes to action. It has 800-foot straightaways and turns banked at only 12 degrees. The demanding layout consistently produces some of the wildest fender rubbing, push-and-shove racing on the circuit.

Martinsville Speedway is the most visitor-friendly track on the NASCAR Cup Series Race Circuit? Stop by on weekdays between 9 am - 4 pm and walk the track for an up-close encounter with the "The Short Track."

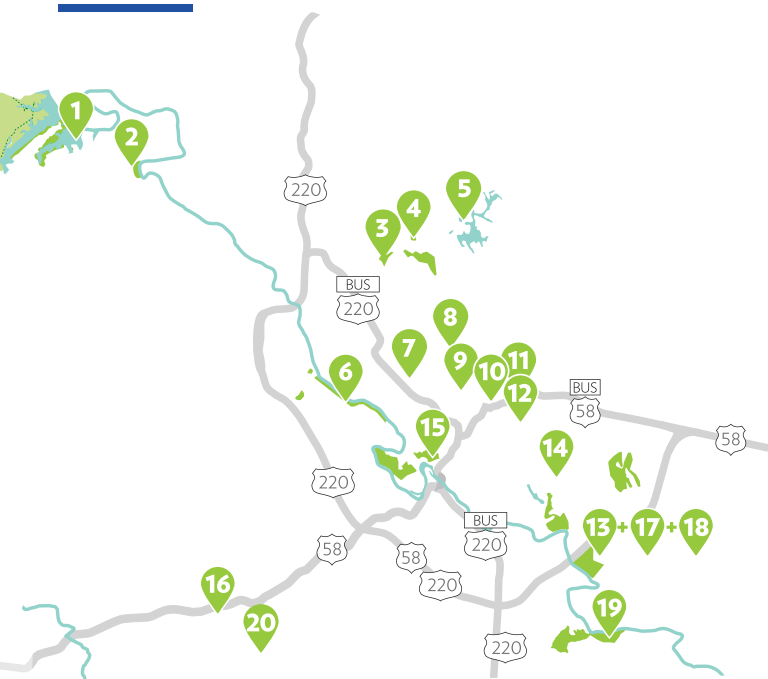

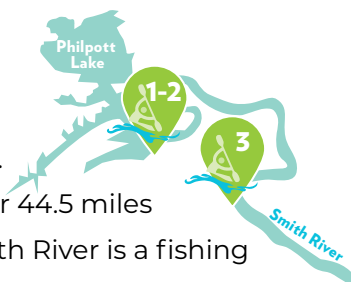

HIT THE WATERS

Cast a line, ride the rapids, or float along the Smith River throughout Martinsville-Henry County. Stretching and winding for 44.5 miles throughout MHC, the Smith River is a fishing hotspot and a paddler's dream. With 11 river access points, it's easy to go with the flow.

The Smith River features 11 public boat ramps for easy access by paddlers and anglers alike. Experience light whitewater rapids during peak generation from Philpott Dam, or launch farther downstream for a more relaxed float.

Anglers will find year-round opportunities, with abundant wild Brown Trout and seasonally stocked Rainbow Trout above the Fieldale access. Downstream stretches offer excellent fishing for Smallmouth Bass, Rock Bass, and Redbreast Sunfish. An adaptive fishing dock at the Monogram Foods Smith River Sports Complex ensures accessible access for all.



Travel time is determined by water level and flow conditions; hydro-electric generation will increase water flows and decrease travel times. A general rule of thumb for planning canoe or kayak trips on gentle moving water is to allow 25-30 minutes per river mile.

This man-made lake covers about 175 acres, offers fishing and boating, and has picnic areas on the shore. Canoes with all equipment can be rented on-site to use on the reservoir.

Home of the lucky fairy stones, Fairy Stone State Park is well known for its 168-acre lake adjoining Philpott Lake, just minutes from the Blue Ridge Parkway. The park offers cabins, a campground, group camping, a conference center, a lodge that sleeps 16, numerous trails, beach swimming, rowboats, canoes, paddle boats, hydro-bikes, picnicking, and two playgrounds.

Nestled among the rolling foothills of Virginia's Blue Ridge Mountains, Philpott Lake is a scenic wonderland. The lake covers 3,000 acres, with 100 miles of shoreline. There are numerous recreational opportunities including boating, swimming, picnicking, hiking, biking, hunting, fishing, and wildlife observation. The lake has nine campgrounds, six beach areas, and nine boat launches.

Enjoy fishing and boating on the lakes and rivers in Martinsville-Henry County and the surrounding area.

PHILPOTT LAKE

Philpott Lake, as seen on FLW Outdoors, is a 3,000 acre reservoir located in the northwest corner of Henry County and is home to Philpott Marina. Walleye, Smallmouth Bass, and Largemouth Bass are just some of the species found here.

And if you want to take a break from fishing, Philpott Lake also offers pleasure boaters and paddlers a variety of places to explore including hidden waterfalls, scenic rock outcrops, and three islands. Deer Island, the largest of the three, offers nightly campsite rentals that are only accessible via boat.

Bowen's Creek Park and Goose Point Park are some of the other recreational areas offered on Philpott.

BEAVER CREEK RESERVOIR

Located near Patrick & Henry Community College, Beaver Creek Reservoir offers 175 acres of water for boating and on-site canoe rentals. Pike is a popular species to fish for in this lake.

ADDITIONAL LAKES

Located just a short drive northeast of Bassett, **Fairy Stone State Park** features a 168-acre lake that adjoins Philpott Lake.

Just under an hour's drive north of Henry County, **Smith Mountain Lake** is a 32 square mile reservoir perfect for fishing, boating, and water recreation sports.

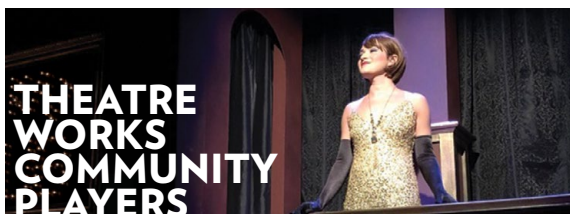

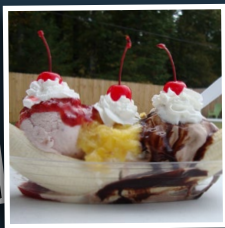
